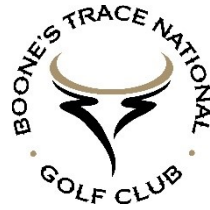

Open to all adults

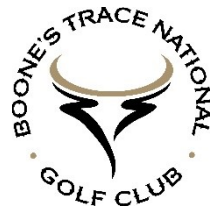

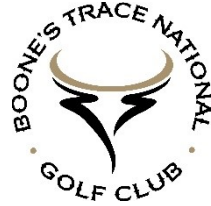
2019 July 4th Flag Day

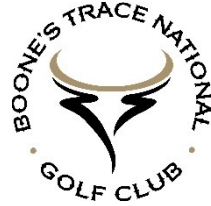

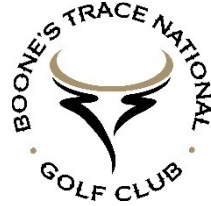

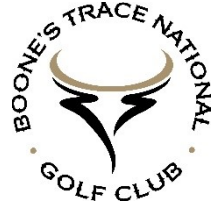

NEW CGA @ Boone's Trace

- WHAT IS IT?:** A newly restructured golf academy that has redirected its focus and strategy into building better golfers. Through each class and performance round the student will learn the basics all the way through to the specifics, in order to reach our goal score of 36 on 9 holes.
- HOW MUCH?:** Each package comes with at least (1) 45 minute lesson per month. Packages start at \$75/month and range through \$250/month.
- TEES:** Every player regardless of skill level starts out 25 yards off the green, plays 9 holes and tries to beat the target score of 36. Once accomplished that player will move back to 50 yards.
